Classification into two sections - General and Specific.

General activities section

Inclusion of issue as a part of regular society activities and activities with FOGSI.

Specific activities section

Special effort and activities addressing issue.

Each section having 5 parts to be given equal weightage.

Each part has 10 marks assigned to it.

Scoring of each part based on subjective judgment and objective parameters.
