Eligibility: Medical doctors under age 40 specializing in Gynecologic Oncology
Belong to a member National Society of AOFOG not in arrears for more than 3 years.

- Attend the KSGO Symposium & ASGO Biennial Meeting (**October 10-12, 2019**)

Selection

1. Up to 5 candidates will be selected.
2. Preference will be given to lower resource countries.
3. There should preferably be only 1 candidate from any one National society.
4. The selection will be done by KSGO and will be final.

Feedback

Within 14 days of completion of the programme, all participants will be required to complete and submit a structured questionnaire to the AOFOG Secretariat which will then forward copies to the KSGO and the respective National Societies. Upon receipt of the completed questionnaire, the AOFOG Secretariat will then send each participant a Certificate of Participation in the Programme.
