As you have already been made aware, the AOFOG Congress in Bali will now be held from **23-26 May 2022**. Due to the continuing uncertainty surrounding the COVID-19 situation, the Organising Committee felt that the most prudent course of action was to plan this Congress as a **“Hybrid Congress”**.

As part of our preliminary preparations, all **National Society members in benefit** are invited to submit a list of proposed speakers from their Society for consideration by the Scientific Committee. The Congress will cover all aspects of Obstetrics & Gynaecology including Education, Training, Medicolegal, Sexual Health, Contraception, Abortion and Gender Issues. As there are many talented and well recognised speakers among your members, we look forward to receiving **between 10 and 15 names from each National Society**. The Scientific Committee in consultation with the AOFOG Executive Board will make the final selection based on the scientific requirements of the Congress while ensuring an equitable distribution among our National Society members.

If the conditions for travel are safe in 2022, we would encourage participation in person. As with previous AOFOG Congresses, we are not in a position to cover the cost of travel and accommodation. However, speakers confirming participation by 1 June 2021 will enjoy a 20% discount on the Registration Fee while those from Low Resource Countries (LRC) will enjoy a 35% discount. (Low Resource countries are: Bangladesh, Cambodia, Egypt, India, Laos, Mongolia, Myanmar, Nepal, Pakistan, Papua New Guinea, Philippines, Sri Lanka and Vietnam.)

If conditions are not safe for travel in 2022, you may elect to make your presentation virtually and you will be given the option to do so by the third quarter of 2021.

We look forward to receiving your list of proposed speakers **by 31 March 2021**.
