

VENUE

Dr Ambedkar International Centre 15, Janpath Rd, Windsor Place, New Delhi

Dr. Ambedkar International Centre The area of state-of-the-art Centre is approximately 3.25 acres in the heart of Delhi and is housed in a 3- storeyed building that includes the administrative block and other facilities. The exterior holds a wide variety of green plants that add to the aesthetics of the place. It has an 18-feet bronze statue of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar, a small Amphitheatre, two Chi ya Arches, two Red Stone Toran Gates, a Buddha Statue, and the imposing Ashoka Stambh on the right facade. The centre has a huge circular area on the ground floor under the dome. Here is a large statue of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar si ng cross-legged on the chair. The information to conduct programmes and to book other facilities is available at the reception at DAIC.

Library and Computer Centre: There is a world-class library on the 2nd floor having workstations with accessibility to e-library with around one million e-resources. The library has a separate reading room and a special sec on on Dr. Ambedkar and Buddhism that has been created for study and research. Besides, there is a computer center for conducting research work. The library is open to the public from 10:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. Monday to Friday, Saturday: 10:30 A.M. to 05:00 P.M.

Auditorium: On the ground floor, there are three Auditoriums 'BHEEM' (700 seats), 'NALANDA' and 'SAMRASTHA' (100 seats each) with attractive interiors. Bheem Hall and Nalanda are equipped with Language translators for 8 languages.

Conference Halls: Two conference halls with 70 sea ng capacity and one with 40 sea ng capacity of international standards are available for booking.

Cafeteria-Cum-Dining Area: On the 2nd floor, visitors and guests can use the facility of the Cafeteria. The booking for Cafeteria-cum-Dining Area is available. Timings: 9:30 AM to 5:30 PM.

VIP Lounge: On the 1st floor, there are 2 VIP lounges with standardized seating arrangements for VIPs.

Security and Safety System: Adequate security and safety measures exist at DAIC that have CCTV cameras, a visitor management system, an X-ray machine, and boom bollards to ensure the safety of the students and employees and the integrity of the property.
