In today's medical landscape, gynecological endoscopy has become an indispensable part of routine practice. However, many medical colleges still lack a comprehensive curriculum to teach this essential skill. To bridge this gap, the EAGLE Project (Every Aspiring Gynecologist Learns Endoscopy) was launched in 2019 by Dr. Sunita Tandulwadkar, the current president of FOGSI, during her tenure as the president of IAGE. The EAGLE project has been launched in FOGSI with great enthusiasm in 2025, spearheaded by the visionary leader and founder, Dr. Sunita Tandulwadkar (President, FOGSI) in collaborative efforts from IAGE (Indian Association of Gynecological Endoscopists) led by president Dr. Atul Ganatra and his team.

A one day live operative endoscopic surgery workshops are being conducted at the medical college affiliated hospitals. The project is being expertly coordinated by the Endoscopy Committee of FOGSI, led by Dr. Sejal Naik (Chairperson, Endoscopy Committee, FOGSI), along with Dr. Subhash Mallya (National Coordinator), Dr. Santwan Mehta (Operational co-ordinator) by their diligent efforts in ensuring the smooth execution of the event. Their combined efforts with IAGE team ensure the project's continued success and expansion. The program included didactic lectures on the fundamentals of endoscopy, complemented by hands-on training using pelvi-trainers. Participants also had the unique opportunity to observe and assist in live Hystero-Laparoscopic surgeries. This groundbreaking initiative has transformed endoscopic training by bringing high-quality sensitisation program directly to postgraduate students in their own medical institutions.

Performing gynecological endoscopy in medical colleges with limited exposure to this technology is challenging. Unlike traditional surgeries, endoscopic procedures require specialized equipment such as high-definition cameras, monitors, light sources, and advanced electro-surgical units. We are grateful to manufacturers for providing essential resources, even in remote areas. A heartfelt thanks to the Heads of Departments and coordinators for their commitment, ensuring approvals and patient responsibility, which has given young gynecologists invaluable academic experience and confidence.

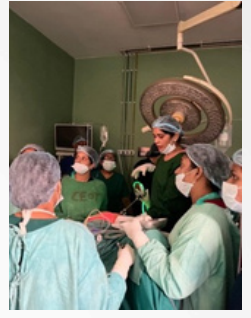

- 2 days extensive workshop with 12 surgeries, 40 resident doctors PG's were given hands on port insertion and hysteroscopy, pelvitrainer training

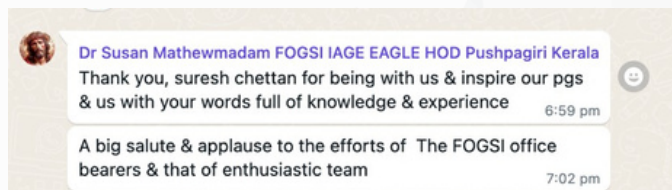


## 9. 22 Feb - Pushpagiri Institute Of Medical Sciences and Research Centre, Tiruvalla

## 11. 27th February in Hind Medical College Barabanki Lucknow



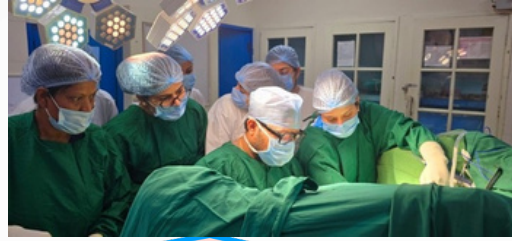
Total 8 cases including two TLH, one myomectomy, two diagnostic Hysteroscopy, two lap ligations and hysteroscopic Cu T removal
