Recognizing a significant gap in endoscopic training across medical colleges, FOGSI has re-energized the EAGLE Project (Every Aspiring Gynecologist Learns Endoscopy) in 2025 under the visionary leadership of Dr. Sunita Tandulwadkar, President of FOGSI and the original founder of the initiative. First launched in 2019 during her tenure as President of IAGE, the project has now evolved into a nationwide movement aimed at strengthening postgraduate education in endoscopy. This renewed phase is being implemented in collaboration with IAGE, under the leadership of its current President, Dr. Kalyan Barmade, bringing together academic excellence and surgical expertise to transform gynecological training across the country.

The EAGLE Project delivers structured and accessible endoscopic training through one-day live operative workshops conducted at medical college-affiliated hospitals. Each program integrates comprehensive didactic lectures, hands-on training using pelvic simulators, and live hystero-laparoscopic surgeries, offering postgraduate students and young gynecologists valuable real-time clinical exposure. Notably, the initiative also extends its impact to patient care by providing free, advanced gynecological surgeries during the workshops—ensuring that expert surgical intervention reaches underserved communities at their doorstep.

The successful execution of this visionary initiative is being led by the FOGSI Endoscopy Committee, under the able leadership of Chairperson Dr. Sejal Naik. Operational coordination is efficiently managed by a dedicated team comprising Dr. Subhash Mallya, Dr. Santwan Mehta, Dr. Ritu Jain, Dr. Aastha Aggarwal and entire EAGLE team. The collaborative efforts of skilled faculty members, department heads, local organizers, and the continued support from valued industry partners have collectively contributed to making the EAGLE Project a nationally impactful and widely appreciated endeavor.

In the month of June alone, the EAGLE Project was successfully conducted across 15 medical colleges nationwide. The June month was started by celebrating the 75th - EAGLE project - the diamond jubilee celebration at Udaipur RNT Medical College on 3rd June. To date, a remarkable 89 EAGLE programs have been completed, providing structured endoscopic training to over 4,500 gynecologists. This large-scale academic initiative has been supported by the invaluable contributions of more than 250 expert faculty members, who have collectively demonstrated over 600 advanced gynecological surgeries using endoscopic techniques.

We extend our sincere appreciation to every individual and organization whose unwavering support has made this transformative journey possible. Through collective effort and shared vision, we are redefining the landscape of gynecological endoscopy and elevating the quality of women's healthcare across the nation—impacting one student, one surgery, and one institution at a time.
