### Guidelines for Poster Presentation

- Poster presentation will be in e-poster or display (4 feet \* 3 feet) format.
- The E-poster will be displayed on standard 42" (Diagonal) LCD
- File format should be Powerpoint (PPT)
- Total size of the presentation should not exceed 10-20 MB
- Maximum number of slides per E-poster: not exceeding 5
- All slides should be in landscape format

### Design specifications

- The text should include Introduction, Aim, Methods, Results, Conclusion and Acknowledgements
- It is suggested that font size of the text should be at least 26 to 36 point. The type font chosen should be a simple and clear one (e.g. Helvetica)
