#### Theme Explaination:

The theme revolves around the symbolism associated with the lotus flower and the hand gesture known as Gyan Mudra. According to this philosophy, the lotus is believed to be the first creation and a sacred womb for both gods and the universe. It is also associated with longevity, fertility, wealth, and knowledge.

The hand gesture, which is depicted with an elongated graceful hand, is a symbol of strength, power, and protection. It is believed to enhance mental strength, sharpen concentration, and improve focus. Holding a pink lotus in the hand represents purity, rebirth, and strength, while yellow lotus represents purity, devotion to God, and knowledge.

The green color is a symbol of fertility and growth, and pink lotus flower is also associated with spiritual enlightenment, growth, purity, and birth. Ultimately, the theme suggests that genuine happiness begins with inner beauty and wisdom, which is very important for firtility.
