CHIEN-TIEN HSU MEMORIAL LECTURE AFOG CONGRESS 23RD-26TH MAY 2022, BALI INDONESIA

I hope this letter finds all of you safe and well.

As you have already been made aware, the AFOG Congress in Bali will now be held from **23-26 May 2022**. Due to the continuing uncertainty surrounding the COVID-19 situation, the Organising Committee felt that the most prudent course of action was to plan this Congress as a **"Hybrid Congress"**.

The CT Hsu Memorial Lecture which is sponsored by the CT Hsu Cancer Research Foundation is held during each AFOG Congress and is considered to be the most prestigious lecture during the Congress.

Nominations are hereby invited for this prestigious Lecture. Nominations should be submitted with a CV and a covering letter justifying the nomination. The nominee need not be from the same National Society but must preferably be from the AFOG region. The subject of the Lecture must be pertinent to the art and science of Obstetrics & Gynaecology with emphasis on Gynaecological Oncology or Endocrinology which were the particular interests of the late Professor Hsu.

Please note that the closing date for nominations has been fixed as 23rd February 2021.

If conditions are not safe for travel in 2022, the lecturer may elect to make the presentation virtually and he/she will be given the option to do so by the third quarter of 2021.

All nominations will be forwarded to the Selection Committee and the successful candidate will be informed on **23rd May 2021**. The CT Hsu Lecturer is required to submit his/her full paper to the JOGR for publication at a later date.
