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

Venue: Manipal Hospital, HAL Old Airport Road, Bengaluru

The workshop is a joint endeavour of Bangalore Society of Obstetrics and Gynaecology and the staff of Manipal Hospital. Critical Care in Obstetrics as a discipline has grown substantially in the last 3 decades and its practice transcends across different specialities. All practicing obstetricians should be well versed with management of obstetric emergencies both in the labor room, HDU and ICU setting. This skill enhancement for service providers in birthing units is a strong way forward for reducing maternal and neonatal mortality and morbidity.

Course Objectives:

At the end of course the delegates would gain the insight and competence based skills in the following areas.

- Managing obstetric emergencies effectively
- Setting up HDU/ICU/NICU at their working place
- Understand the implications and management principles of Hypertensive Disorders, Cardiac, Endocrine, Metabolic, Embolic, Haemotological, Autoimmune critical problems in pregnancy
- CPR, resuscitative hysterotomy and neonatal resuscitation
- NIV, ventilator goals and objectives in pregnancy
- Capacity building for managing difficult births and handling birth trauma in the labour room
- Catastrophic Obstetric Haemorrhage: Transfusion triggers, POCT Rotem, Monitoring of End points, Post Resuscitation care
- Nutritional Support Objective: prevention of lactation failure
