



Q1. What is the approximate prevalence (frequency) of Polycystic Ovary Syndrome in your practice?




Q2. What is the commonest age group which presents with symptoms of PCOS? 946 responses




Q3. With what symptoms do patients of PCOS present to you?






Q5. Do you routinely advise FSH,LH & Testosterone levels for PCOS patients:  $^{946\,\mathrm{responses}}$ 




Q6. Do you routinely use pelvic ultrasonography in the diagnostic criteria for PCOS? 946 responses



Q7. Do you routinely use Anti-Müllerian Hormone for the diagnosis of PCOS? 946 responses




Q8. Do you advise serum insulin levels for PCOS? 946 responses










### Q12. Preferred treatment for PCOS with acne & hirsuitism:
